What is a scholarship?

A scholarship is a sum of money or other financial assistance given to a student to help support their study. Scholarships are not loans. The money is given to you provided you fulfil key requirements, such as academic performance, work experience or volunteer commitments. Scholarships have different eligibility criteria, application procedures and closing dates, so check these carefully early on in the process.
