

**CBS SCHOOL OF ACCOUNTING HONOURS SCHOLARSHIP
2015 TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

WHAT THIS SCHOLARSHIP PROVIDES

The CBS School of Accounting Honours Scholarship for semester 1, 2015 will provide the following support for up to a maximum of one year (based on a full-time study load of 100 credits per semester):

Any study that is taken over and above the remaining expected duration of your honours year will not be covered.

- 1) A total value of up to \$3,000 paid as a cash stipend of \$1,500 per semester. The stipend can be used at your discretion to contribute towards educational related expenses.
 - a. If you commenced your Honours program in semester 2, 2014 you will receive a one-off payment of \$1,500 in semester 1, 2015.

If you receive a Centrelink payment, you should declare to Centrelink any scholarships you are awarded.

The Australian Tax Office has a "[Is your scholarship taxable?](#)" tool on their website to help you determine if your scholarship is taxable. For expert advice please contact the Australian Taxation Office (www.ato.gov.au) or your accountant.

CONDITIONS THAT NEED TO BE MET TO KEEP YOUR SCHOLARSHIP

- 1) Deferral not permitted.
- 2) Unless there are **exceptional circumstances** you must:
 - Remain enrolled in an Accounting Honours Major.
 - Maintain a full-time enrolment of 100 credits per semester at Curtin University. If any study is undertaken below 100 credits per semester, you are required to seek approval for this change from the Scholarships Office.
 - Maintain a course weighted average (CWA) of at least 70 and pass all enrolled units per semester. Academic monitoring of scholarship recipients will occur each semester.
- 3) If you withdraw from your units or course of study or are terminated from your course of study, you will become ineligible for continuation of this scholarship. Your scholarship will cease immediately and you will be required to repay to Curtin University any stipend awarded for that study period.
- 4) The CBS School of Accounting Honours Scholarship has been awarded for the Accounting Honours course within the faculty of CBS at Curtin University and is not transferable into any other course, major or university.

Unless there are **exceptional circumstances**, if you have unsatisfactory progress or breach the scholarship conditions, you shall be ineligible to retain the scholarship.

Exceptional circumstances must be forwarded in writing to the Scholarships Office, along with supporting documentation. The Scholarships Office will then assess your request and will advise you of the outcome.

PAYMENTS

The CBS School of Accounting Honours Scholarship will commence from semester 1, 2015.

Cash payments of \$1,500 will be paid to your nominated bank account each semester.

Cash payments are based on full-time enrolment of 100 credits per semester.

If you commenced your Honours Program in semester 2, 2014 you will receive a once-off payment in semester 1, 2015 at the end of September.

If you are commencing your Honours Program in semester 1, 2015 your first payment will be processed at the end of April and your final semester payment will occur end September 2015.

Note: Your scholarship payment will appear on your bank statement with the reference as follows: DEPOSIT CONCUR TECHNOLOG CP#####.
