



**SIR CHARLES COURT LEADERSHIP AWARD
2016 TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

WHAT THIS AWARD PROVIDES

The Sir Charles Court Award for 2016 has been awarded to students who have successfully completed the Sir Charles Court Young Leaders Program and enrolled into an undergraduate degree at Curtin University.

The Award will provide the following support as a one off payment:

- 1) Cash payment of \$3,000. The amount can be used at your discretion to contribute towards educational related expenses.

This award does not preclude recipients from holding other Curtin funded scholarships.

If you receive a Centrelink payment, you should declare to Centrelink any Award you have received.

The Australian Tax Office has a "[Is your Scholarship taxable?](#)" tool on their website to help you determine if your Award is taxable. For expert advice please contact the Australian Taxation Office or your accountant.

CONDITIONS THAT NEED TO BE MET TO KEEP YOUR AWARD

- 1) Have a current full-time enrolment of at least 75 credits in an undergraduate course at Curtin University.
- 2) If you cease studies at Curtin, either voluntarily (e.g. by withdrawing from course or units) or involuntarily (e.g. termination from course due to unsatisfactory course progress or suspension, termination or expulsion due to misconduct) in the semester of award, you will become ineligible to receive this scholarship. The Sir Charles Court Award will cease immediately and you will be required to repay any stipend awarded.
- 3) The Sir Charles Court Award is not transferable to another university.

PAYMENTS

The cash payment of the Award will be paid to your nominated bank account in one instalment of \$3,000 and will occur approximately mid-end April 2016.

Note: Your Award payment will appear on your bank statement with the reference as follows: DEPOSIT CONCUR TECHNOLOG CP#####.

AWARD ACCEPTANCE AND CONSENT

- I have read, understood and accept the attached terms and conditions governing the Sir Charles Court Award and I agree to abide by these conditions and obligations outlined therein.

- I understand that if I fail to meet my obligations as outlined in the terms and conditions, I risk my award being terminated. Should this occur, I understand I will not be eligible to receive the cash payment.
