2015 TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

WHAT THIS SCHOLARSHIP PROVIDES

The WA School of Mines Graduates Association Leadership Scholarship for 2015 will provide the following support for up to a maximum of three years (based on a full-time study load of 100 credits per semester):

- 1) A total value of up to \$30,000 paid as a cash stipend of \$5,000 per semester. The stipend can be used at your discretion to contribute towards educational related expenses.
- 2) Possible opportunity for vacation work, mentoring support and networking through WA School of Mines Graduates Association.

The scholarship is offered for study that is undertaken at the WA School of Mines Kalgoorlie campus only. Any study that is undertaken at a campus other than Kalgoorlie will not be covered by the scholarship.

Any study that is taken over and above the expected duration of your initial degree will be at your expense.

If you receive a Centrelink payment, you should declare to Centrelink any scholarships you are awarded.

CONDITIONS THAT NEED TO BE MET TO KEEP YOUR SCHOLARSHIP

To retain eligibility for a WA School of Mines Graduates Association Leadership Scholarship you must:

- 1) Unless there are **exceptional circumstances**:
 - Remain enrolled in an initial course and major of study.
 - Maintain a full-time enrolment of 100 credit points per semester at the WA School of Mines Kalgoorlie campus. If any study is undertaken below 100 credits per semester, you are required to seek approval for this change from the Scholarships Office in consultation with a representative of the WA School of Mines Graduates Association.
 - Remain eligible for a Commonwealth Supported place at Curtin University (this means you must be an Australian or New Zealand citizen or the holder of an Australian Permanent Humanitarian or Permanent Resident visa) and be residing in Australia.
 - Maintain a course weighted average (CWA) of at least 60 and pass all enrolled units per semester. Academic monitoring of scholarship recipients will occur each semester.
 - Leave of absence is not permitted.
 - Participate in the WA School of Mines Graduates Association events.
- 2) You are ineligible to apply for or receive any other industry funded scholarships whilst in receipt of the WA School of Mines Leadership Scholarship.
- 3) Deferral of this scholarship is not permitted.
- 4) If you withdraw from your units or course of study or are terminated from your course of study, you will become ineligible for continuation of this scholarship. Your scholarship will cease immediately and you will be required to repay to Curtin University any stipend awarded for that study period.
- 5) The WA School of Mines Graduates Association Leadership Scholarship has been awarded for a particular course and major at the WA School of Mines Kalgoorlie campus and is not transferable into any other course, major, campus or university.

Unless there are **exceptional circumstances**, if you have unsatisfactory progress or breach the scholarship conditions, you shall be ineligible to retain the scholarship. If you do not meet all the conditions outlined, you may be placed on breached status which will provide an opportunity for you to improve your grades in the next semester exams. This opportunity would occur only once for the duration of the scholarship and is at the discretion of the Scholarships Office in consultation with a representative of the WA School of Mines Graduates Association.

Exceptional circumstances must be forwarded to and shall be at the discretion of the Scholarships Office in consultation with a representative of the WA School of Mines Graduates Association. Supporting original documentation (e.g. medical, counselling) must be provided.

PAYMENTS

The WA School of Mines Graduates Association Leadership Scholarship will commence from semester 1, 2015.

Cash payments of \$5,000 will be paid to your nominated bank account each semester.

Cash payments are based on full-time enrolment of 100 credits per semester.

First and second semester payments will occur post census dates (thus approx. mid-end April and mid-end Sept dependant on the receipt of payment from external sponsor).

Note: Your scholarship payment will appear on your bank statement with the reference as follows: DEPOSIT CONCUR TECHNOLOG CP#####.
