



**CBS INDIGENOUS UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP
2015 TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

WHAT THIS SCHOLARSHIP PROVIDES

The CBS Indigenous Undergraduate Scholarship for semester 1, 2015 will provide the following support for up remaining expected duration of your undergraduate degree (based on a full-time study load of 100 credits per semester): Any study that is taken over and above the scholarship will not be covered.

- 1) The cost of the student tuition fees
- 2) A \$750 book voucher per semester to purchase course-related textbooks and materials from the Curtin University Co-op Bookshop.

If you receive a Centrelink payment, you should declare to Centrelink any scholarships you are awarded.

The Australian Tax Office has a "[Is your scholarship taxable?](#)" tool on their website to help you determine if your scholarship is taxable. For expert advice please contact the Australian Taxation Office (www.ato.gov.au) or your accountant.

CONDITIONS THAT NEED TO BE MET TO KEEP YOUR SCHOLARSHIP

- 1) Deferral not permitted.
- 2) Unless there are **exceptional circumstances** you must:
 - Remain enrolled in a CBS undergraduate degree.
 - Maintain a full-time study load of 100 credits each semester at Curtin University.
 - Remain eligible for a Commonwealth Supported place at Curtin University (this means you must be an Australian citizen, Australian permanent resident, Australian permanent humanitarian or New Zealand citizen) and be residing in Australia.
 - Maintain a course weighted average (CWA) of at least 50 and pass all units each semester. Academic monitoring of scholarship recipients will occur each semester.
- 3) If you withdraw from your units or course of study or are terminated from your course of study, you will become ineligible for continuation of this scholarship. Your scholarship will cease immediately and you will be required to repay to Curtin University any stipend awarded for that study period.
- 4) The CBS Indigenous Undergraduate Scholarship has been awarded for a particular course and major at Curtin University and is not transferable into any other faculty or university.

Unless there are **exceptional circumstances**, if you have unsatisfactory progress or breach the scholarship conditions, you shall be ineligible to retain the scholarship.

Exceptional circumstances must be forwarded in writing to the Scholarships Office, along with supporting documentation. The Scholarships Office will then assess your request and will advise you of the outcome.

PAYMENTS

The CBS Indigenous Undergraduate Scholarship will commence from semester 1, 2015.

The \$750 bookshop voucher will be provided to you each semester and you will be advised by the Scholarships Office when it is available for pick-up.

The cost of the student tuition fees will be paid based on a full-time enrolment of 100 credits per semester.
